About

This instructor-led class is for school personnel or family members who have little or no experience with braille. In the class, participants will visually learn how to read and write braille. They will also gain knowledge to effectively support students who use braille. This class requires participants to spend time learning in and out of class; they will demonstrate their knowledge by submitting assignments each week. A certificate of completion will be issued by the Michigan Department of Education.

- the Nemeth Braille Code for Mathematics

This class is for adult family members and school personnel supporting students in Michigan who are Blind/Visually Impaired (BVI), and college students in Michigan who are studying a BVI-related field.
