



Spring Unified English Braille Class

About

This instructor-led class is for school personnel who have little or no experience with braille. In the class, participants will visually learn how to read and write braille. They will also gain knowledge to effectively support students who use braille. This class requires participants to spend time in and out of class learning braille; they will demonstrate their knowledge by submitting assignments each week. A certificate of completion will be issued by the Michigan Department of Education.

- the Nemeth Braille Code for Mathematics
