This eight-week course will focus on several technical aspects of American Sign Language (ASL), including structure, grammar, classifiers, multiple meanings, and technical signs. This course is for professionals who are not interpreters but have intermediate ASL skills and work with students who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing (DHH).

Participants will identify and apply:

- 1. ASL structure, grammatical features, and use of classifiers
- 2. Multiple meanings from English to ASL
- 3. Multiple meanings from ASL to English
- 4. Strategies for representing key vocabulary
- 5. Technical signs using ASL
