



DHH Swap Meet: West Michigan

Event Description

This half-day event will include a specially-recorded presentation by Tina Childress, an educational audiologist who is widely respected for her knowledge and expertise with cochlear implants, assistive technology, aural rehabilitation, and the social-emotional implications of hearing loss on children. Childress' presentation will provide the most up-to-date and effective resources and tools for technology, connectivity, online learning, and accessibility for students who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing (DHH).

The second part of the event will allow time for attendees to “swap,” or share, resources and ideas. Each attendee will take a few minutes to share an effective tool, resource, practice, or activity for supporting the needs of children and students who are DHH and their families. Attendees will also have time to share common challenges, brainstorm solutions, and network with others. Notes and resources will be captured and shared after the event.
