This one-day conference is for Michigan transition coordinators, counselors, social workers, teachers, and consultants for students who are Blind or Visually Impaired (BVI), Deaf or Hard of Hearing (DHH), or DeafBlind (DB). The conference will include a keynote presentation by Stephanie Cawthon, director of the National Deaf Center on Postsecondary Outcomes. It will also include general sessions and breakout sessions aimed toward transition needs and services for students who are BVI, DHH, or DB.

- Learn about transition-based agencies and programs for students who are BVI, DHH, or DB
