Google Hangouts Using Windows

- Few keyboard shortcuts available
- Screen sharing does not share computer audio
- Everything is web-based
- Need to be familiar with their screen reader's web navigation capabilities

Launching Google Hangouts

- Open your browser, press Alt+D to bring up the address bar, and navigate to [Google Hangouts](https://hangouts.google.com) (hangouts.google.com)
- Sign in to Gmail with username and password, or set up an account

Main Hangouts Window

- Navigate by buttons
- Hit space or enter on the menu button
 - Navigate with the up and down arrow keys
- Available buttons:
 - Contacts
 - Conversations
 - Phone calls
 - Video calls

Google Hangouts Using iOS Devices

- To hear all objects in the app from beginning to end:
 - Swipe up with 2 fingers
 - Single tap with 2 fingers to pause reading on button you'd like to select
 - Double tap with 1 finger to select object
 - Single tap with 2 fingers to continue listening to objects in app from current location to end
