To ensure equal access to a quality education for all students who are BVI and/or DHH.

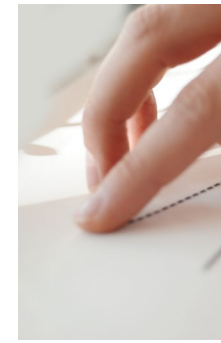
